Support scaffold footings must be level and capable of supporting the loaded scaffold. The legs, poles, frames, and uprights must bear on base plates and mud sills. a. Keep the scaffold level, plumb, and square. b. Don't use bricks, blocks, barrels, or other unstable objects to level a scaffold. Power lines
