When pulled, the clutch disengages the engine and allows you to shift gears. Getting a feel for using the clutch is essential for driving a manual motorcycle.

Caution: Similar to driving a manual car, when shifting between lower gears, you should release the clutch slowly. The shift lever is used for shifting and is on the left foot position in front of the left side foot peg. Press up firmly for upshift, and press down firmly for downshift. Note: The shift pattern on motorcycles is 1 down and 5 up. The gear order from down to up is 1-neutral-2-3-4-5-6, as shown in the shift pattern pictures.

How to Ride a Motorcycle for Beginners : 6 Steps (with ...

Begin driving your motorcycle. Once the engine has started and warmed up, you can begin to ride. This is done by shifting down into 1st gear and letting the clutch lever out while simultaneously pulling back on the throttle. Make sure your kickstand isn't out. Slowly let out the clutch lever until the bike starts to roll forward.

The rider uses handlebars to turn the motorcycle. At slow speeds you turn the handlebars in the direction you want to go. At higher speeds you press outward on the handlebar on the side of the direction you want to go. That's like turning the handlebar (with pressure only) in the wrong direction.

Riding a manual motorcycle requires that the gears are changed by the rider manually rather than automatically. Gears enable the rider to match the power of the engine to the speed on the road. Low gears for low speeds and higher gears for higher speeds.

Center stands, mounted beneath the motorcycle, require the bike to be rocked forward. Stand to the left of the bike, place your left hand on the left handle and straighten the front tire. Place your right foot on the center stand's tang to make sure it's flush on the ground, then push your bike gently forward.

How To Drive A Manual Motorcycle For A Newbie Note: Do not be in a hurry to release the clutch lever completely, continue to coordinate the throttle and the clutch until the motorcycle is moving. As the motorcycle increases speed, continue to ease the clutch lever out smoothly and slowly.

Most motorcycles are manual transmissions and need to be shifted up or down as you accelerate and decelerate. Look for the clutch above the left handlebar. It will look similar to the handle that controls your brakes. Find the shifter in front of your left foot and control it with the up and down lever.
